

NHISD BASKETBALL GAME AND TICKETING PROCEDURES FOR HOME AND DISTRICT GAMES

The University Interscholastic League (UIL) has provided information concerning operational and mitigation guidelines which New Home ISD will implement when hosting and traveling to basketball games throughout the 2020-2021 season. The following procedures were developed with the health and well-being of our students, staff, families and communities as the top priority.

This policy is subject to change at any time.

- Stadium attendance is limited to 50% capacity. Home capacity is 170 spectators and visitor capacity is 150 spectators.
- Each school establishes their stadium capacity and spectator limitations for both teams.
- UIL District 6-AA rules will govern all district contests

GAME PROCEDURES FOR NEW HOME ISD LEOPARD GYM

- **EVERY PERSON MUST HAVE A WRISTBAND OR DISTRICT PASS TO GET INTO THE VARSITY GAMES.**
- All spectators will pay at the gate – your wristband will provide you the opportunity to enter the game
- JV and Junior High games do not require a wristband to enter.
 - Junior High games will be played simultaneously with the boys in one gym and the girls in the other - spectators must enter at the gym they are wanting to watch - no one will be allowed to pass through the school
- When applicable, the gym will be cleared and disinfected at the conclusion of the last JV game.
- JV spectators will enter on the south entrance of the gym and exit on the north through the cafeteria exit.
- Varsity spectators will enter the gym on the south entrance once the gym has been completely emptied and disinfected.
- Spectators will be asked to quickly exit the gym at the conclusion of the last game.
- All spectators will be required to wear a mask at all times unless seated or eating and drinking in the commons area.

TICKET PROCEDURES

Home Games

- Basketball players, managers, cheerleaders & coaches will each receive 4 wristbands per family.
- NHISD Secondary students will have the opportunity to obtain 1 wristband.
- Wristbands are valid for only the game that they are indicated..

Road Games

- The number of visitor spectators will be at the discretion of the host school.
- NHISD will follow the same distribution procedures as for home games.
- The number of wristbands or passes to be distributed to New Home players, managers, cheerleaders & coaches will be based on the amount of passes allotted by the host school.
